This is a basic hand that several misplayed and went down. Just about every time it was played, the lead was 7S. The danger is that one hand, probably North given South's long spades, will have 4 hearts. West must play KH first, retaining a finessing position should either opponent show out, then finesse 9H, play AH, come to hand with KC, and then draw last heart.

Only one player led AD but did not follow that by playing 9D despite partner's positive signal.
