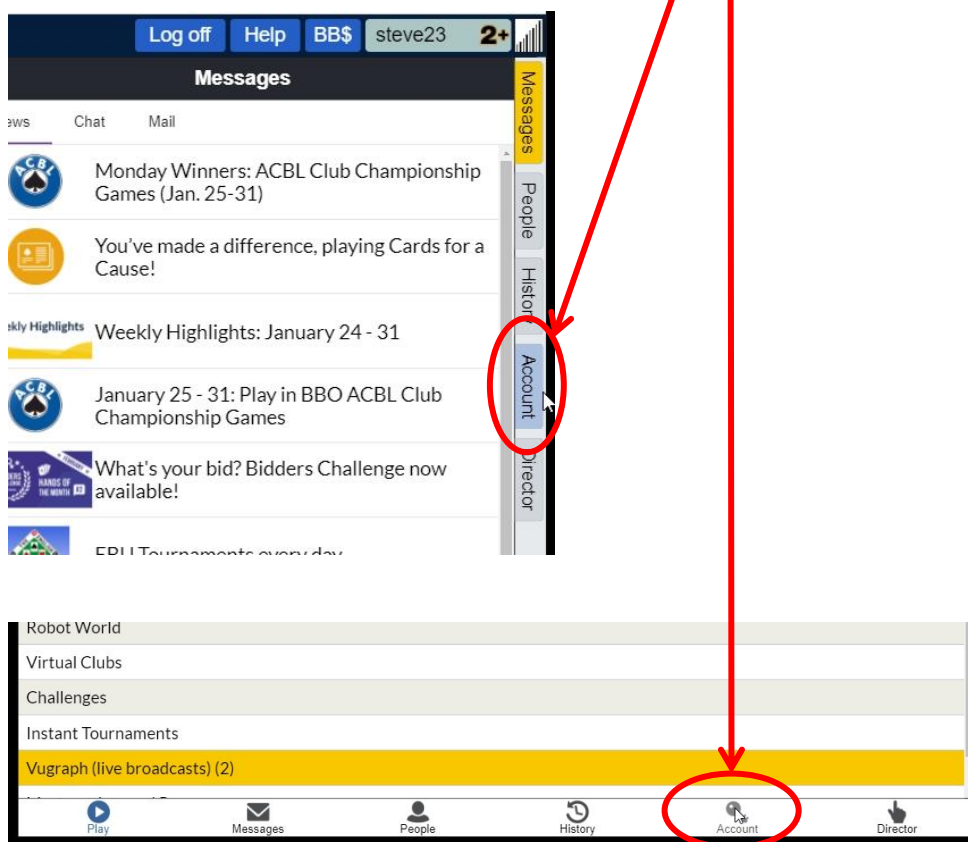
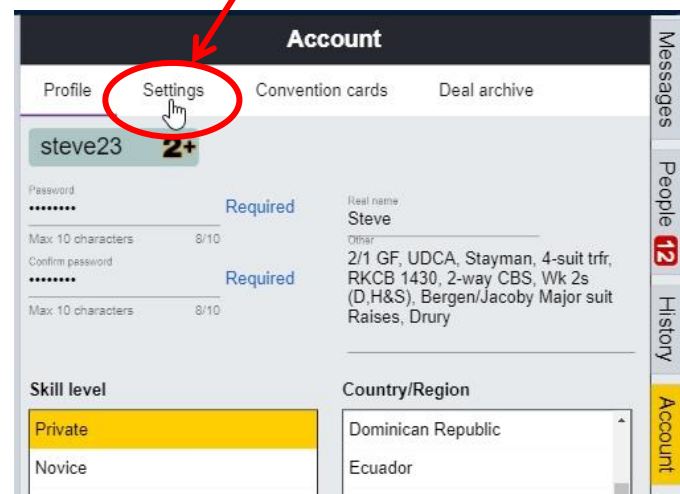


BBO TIP #1 – How to Guard Against Mis-clicks (and avoid the need for UNDOs)

Step 1: Log into BBO, then click on the “Account” tab (on the right or at the bottom of your screen, depending on your current settings).

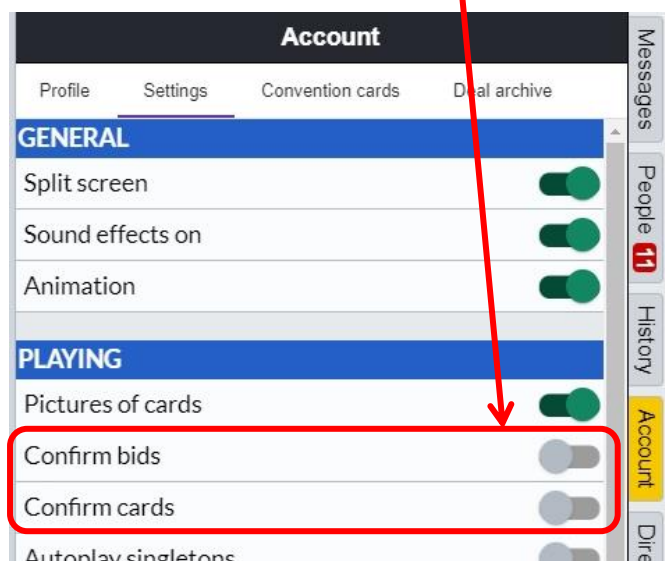


Step 2: Click on “Settings”.

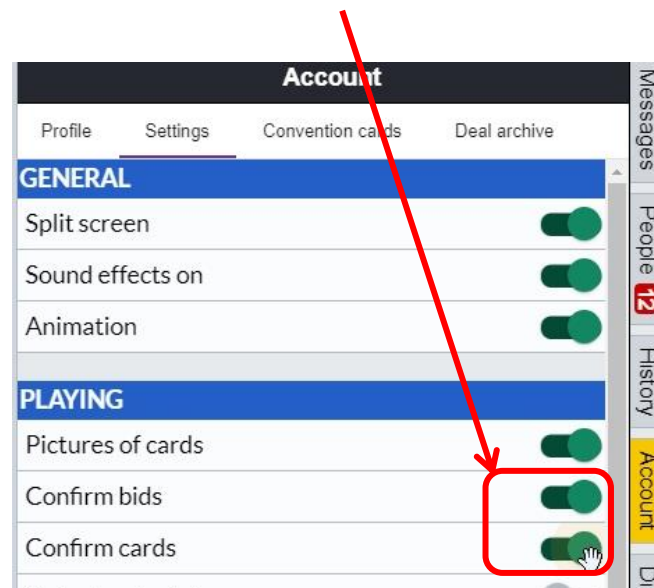


BBO TIP #1 – How to Guard Against Mis-clicks (and avoid the need for UNDOs)

Step 3: Locate the two settings “**Confirm bids**” and “**Confirm cards**”. (NB. By default, both toggle switches will be in the **OFF** position.)

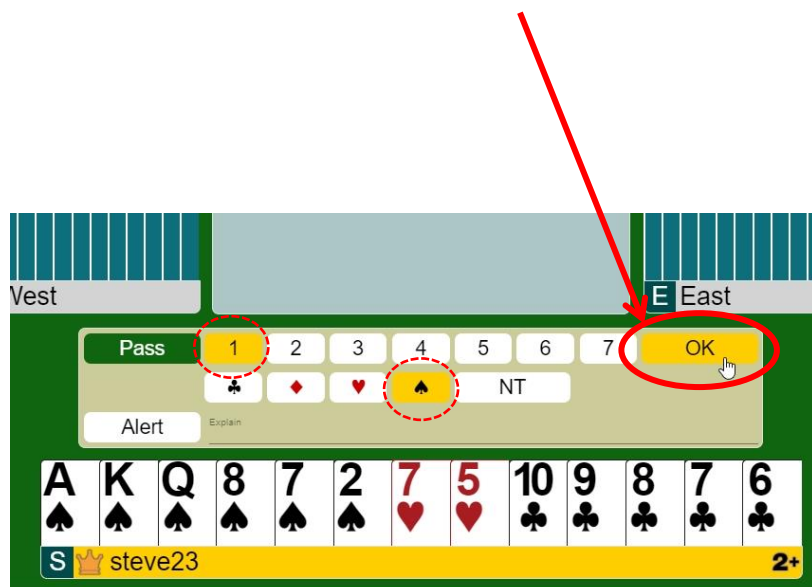


Step 4: Click each switch to toggle between **ON** (displays green) and **OFF** (displays grey) according to your preferences. (NB. You can do this at any time, even while playing in a tournament.)



BBO TIP #1 – How to Guard Against Mis-clicks (and avoid the need for UNDOs)

Step 5: With “**Confirm bids**” turned **ON**, you start by selecting your bid in the usual way (alerting and explaining when required) – i.e. by clicking “1” and then clicking the “♠” suit symbol, in the example shown here. When you have selected your bid, an **OK** button will appear which you must click to confirm your bid.



Step 6: With “**Confirm cards**” turned **ON**, you click on a card once to select it and a second time to confirm you wish to play it. When selected, your card is highlighted as shown in these examples. (NB. If you realise you have selected the wrong card, just click once on the correct card and a second time to play it.)
